

INFORMATION FROM THE CONTROL COMMISSION

The 2019 General Assembly will be our first with a Control Commission, and we very much look forward to seeing you all in Madrid in October.

Stand for election

Nominations are now open for all roles to be elected at the 2019 General Assembly. All members of full organisations and affiliated organisations are eligible to run for election, as are Activist members. All roles are two year terms. The roles available are:

Rainbow Rose Board

- Secretary General
- President
- Treasurer
- Vice President (x3 places)
- Board member (x3 places)

Control Commission

- Member of Control Commission (x3 places)

Candidates for all positions must submit:

- a CV;
- a nomination letter from their member organisation*;
- a letter of motivation .

These must be received electronically by the Control Commission at control@rainbowrose.eu by the **deadline** for the receipt of nominations, which is **WEDNESDAY 18th SEPTEMBER 2019 at 1600 CET**.

All candidates must be eligible to run in accordance with the rules and statutes of Rainbow Rose, which are available [here](#).

We will endeavour to support all potential candidates in their nomination process and are very happy to give information and advice via control@rainbowrose.eu. We recommend that candidates submit their nominations well in advance of the deadline, to allow for any advice and guidance should their submission be invalid, as the deadline for nominations is final.

Motions

Ordinary motions, proposals to modify the statutes and proposals to modify the rules of procedure can be submitted to the General Assembly by the Board, Full Members and Associate Members. These must be submitted to the Control Commission at control@rainbowrose.eu. The **deadline** for the receipt of all motions is **WEDNESDAY 18th SEPTEMBER 2019 at 1600 CET**. As with nominations for election, we are happy to give guidance and advice. As it is an election year, while motions on the election process can be submitted, they will not change any procedures or activities related to the 2019 elections.
